#### **ELIGIBILITY AND TEAM COMPOSITION**

- 1. All students pursuing undergraduate (three/five year) or postgraduate law degrees from any law school/university/college recognized by the Bar Council of India are eligible to participate in the Essay Competition.
- 2. Co-authorship of a maximum of TWO authors is permitted.

#### **GENERAL GUIDELINES**

- 1. The essay must be the original and bonafide work of the participating author.
- 2. Only one submission per author or a team of co-authors is permissible. In case of more than one submission, only the one received first would be considered for review.
- 3. Winners form each topic would have the opportunity to publish their essay on the CLPRS blog. In case of Co-Authors they shall collectively be given a cash prize of 1500.
