

RULES FOR THE INTER COLLEGE DEBATE COMPETITION

ELIGIBILITY & TEAM COMPOSITION

- Members of the team must be valid Undergraduate students pursuing a recognized Bachelor of Law program. (Note – Bachelor of Law means a 3 year or 5 years integrated course in Law recognized by the Bar Council of India).
- The team comprises of two participants.
 - Students from same College / University can participate as a team.
 - Two teams from one College / University can participate in the competition. Basis of preference is first come first basis.

TOPIC

Preliminary Round - **Status of Human Rights in India**

Final Round - **Incorporation of Human Rights in Indian Constitution and it's Efficacy**

ROUNDS

- There are two rounds in the competition i.e. Preliminary and Final
 - **Preliminary Round :**
 - i. Each team shall consist of two speakers, one speaking for the motion and one against the motion which will be decided by the participants themselves.
 - ii. Each Candidate will be allotted 3+1 minutes in Preliminary Round.
 - iii. There shall be no rebuttal in this round.
 - **Final Round :**
 - i. Top 6 participants will qualify for final round.
 - ii. The motion would be given by the organizers after the declaration of results of preliminary round.
 - iii. Each Candidate will be allowed 5+1 minutes in Final Round.
 - iv. The motion would be decided by draw of lots.
 - v. There would be rebuttal in this round.
- N.B. : Be prepared for both the motion in advance.**

**NB : Registration is Free.
Competition will be conducted offline.
No accommodation will be provided.**

REGISTRATION

The teams will have to register themselves by filling the google form (<https://forms.gle/zinw7HJCpipbwwEj8>) kindly complete and submit the registration form not later than 11:59 pm on 08th December, 2022.

- The Composition of the team cannot be changed once a team has registered.
- Upon successful submission of Registration form, the teams will receive an email from the Organizers, providing them with their Team Code and informing them of their successful Registration.
- If teams do not receive such an email, it may contemporaneously send an email with its registration details to *sociolegalrslw@gmail.com* or directly contact the members of the organizing committee.

LANGUAGE

- The medium of communication will be English only.

DRESS CODE

- The dress code for the competition is law student's uniform (Black and White). Participants must adhere to the same.

GENERAL RULES

- The Speakers shall not disclose their identities and shall only represent themselves by the Team Codes allotted to them. Team codes shall be provided to each team after successful registration.
- The competition shall consist of 2 rounds i.e. Preliminary and Final.
- It is mandatory to keep your college ID cards with you at the time of debate competition.
- Use of foul or obscene language will lead to disqualification.
- No book, document or electronic gadget shall be allowed to the participant during the competition.

NB : Registration is Free.
Competition will be conducted offline.
No accommodation will be provided.

- Decision made by the panel of Judges will be final and binding.
- **The decision taken by the Organizers shall be final.**
- Reporting time would be shared on whatsapp group after registration.

 - Organization and Clarity
 - Presentation Style
 - Knowledge of Subject
 - Originality and Ingeniousness
 - Ability to deal with question and rebuttals concisely and effectively.
